We have a very exciting term coming up for Hunter Singers, with lot of gigs and important events leading up to our Brisbane Tour. The details are included below. The first Hunter Singers rehearsal for this term will be on **Tuesday 2 May** at Merewether High School Learning Centre.

SECONDARY CHORAL CONCERT TUESDAY 16 MAY

The Secondary Choral Concert will be held at Sydney Town Hall on Tuesday 16 May. The concert will feature Faure's Requiem, *Jandamarra* by Paul Stanhope, and guest artist Felix Riebl from The Cat Empire. I know the singers will have a wonderful day. There will be a regional rehearsal for this event at Hunter School of the Performing Arts on Friday 28 April. Liz Scott from The Arts Unit will conduct the rehearsal. The bus will leave Merewether High School (Pokolbin Street) at 7am on 16 May and return to the same point at approximately 11.30pm. The cost for the Sydney excursion is \$70, which includes the music, participation fee and bus fare. The Hunter Singers black trees T-shirt is to be worn with jeans during the day. Girls will change into the 'peacock' tops and performance pants for the performance and boys will change into the performance uniform with tie. Singers should bring lunch and snacks to eat during the day. They will also need money to purchase dinner (around \$20). *Uniform: Wear black trees with jeans and joggers. Take performance blacks with peacock tops (girls), black shirt/blue tie (boys).*

STAR STRUCK

Hunter Singers have a strong role in Star Struck this year, as featured performers on stage in four songs. At other times throughout the show, Singers will perform with the Massed Choir, instead of waiting outside in the shed as per previous years. No one will be permitted to remain in the sheds. All singers must be part of the Massed Choir or another featured role in the show. Featured artists, dancers, musicians and backing vocalists will join with Singers during their featured items where possible. The rehearsal and performance dates are 15 May, 9 June and 15-17 June. Information regarding Star Struck is on page 4 of this letter. Cost for the participation fees, T-Shirt and choir props will be \$55.

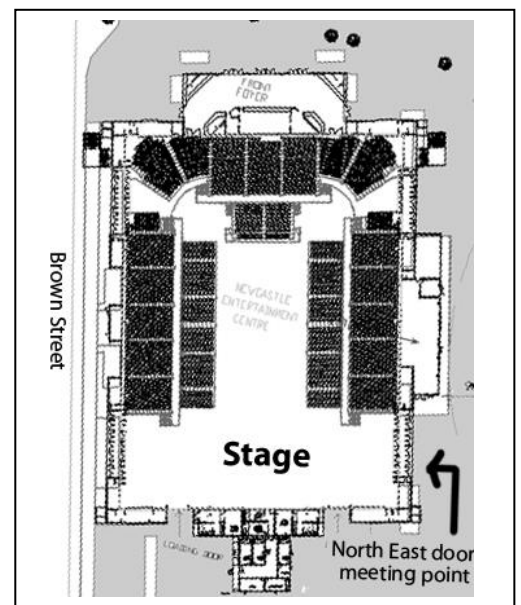

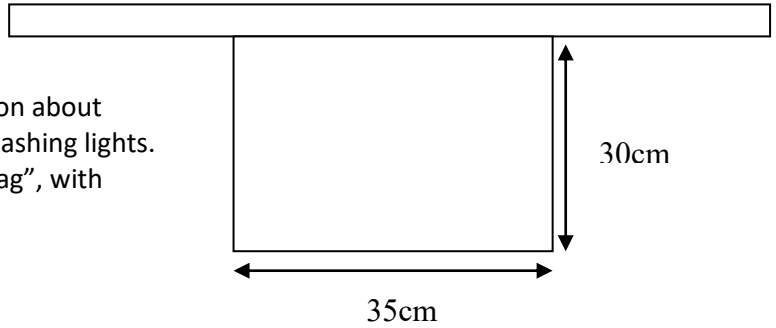

White Star Struck T-Shirt (Provided), black performance pants, black socks. You will receive further information about costume for the featured item and choir props and flashing lights. All choir props will be collected in a black "goodies bag", with construction details provided below.



BLACK "Goodies" bag.

- Made from black cotton
- Dimensions of bag is 35cm wide x 30cm long, with 4cm wide ties.
- Length of ties to suit individuals, tied around the waist with bag sitting on hip.
- Alternatively, bags may be fashioned from black supermarket shopping bags with straps

Cost

The cost for T-shirt, props, flashing light and the new participation fee is \$55. Please pay with your term fees.

Bring

A water bottle, snacks, Lunch for Thursday, and dinner for Friday if desired. Bring a jacket for interval and after the show. You can keep a backpack in the holding area outside, but don't keep valuables in your bag, bring your money in a small purse to keep in your pocket.
