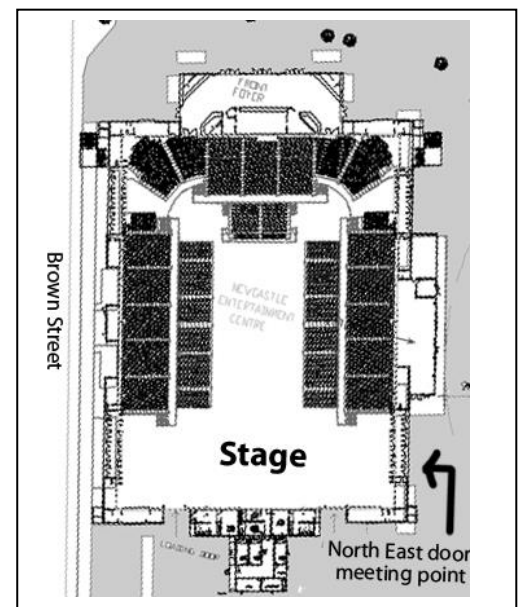

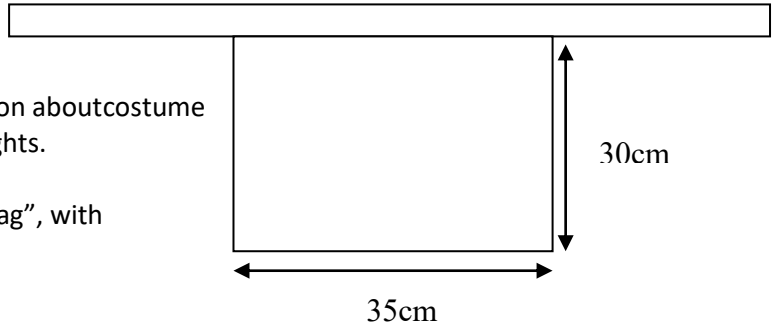

## Costume

White Star Struck T-Shirt (Provided), black performance pants, black socks. You will receive further information about costume for the featured item and choir props and flashing lights.

All choir props will be collected in a black “goodies bag”, with construction details provided below.



## BLACK “Goodies” bag.

- Made from black cotton
- Dimensions of bag is 35cm wide x 30cm long, with 4cm wide ties.
- Length of ties to suit individuals, tied around the waist with bag sitting on hip.
- Alternatively, bags may be fashioned from black supermarket shopping bags with straps

## Cost

The cost for T-shirt, props, flashing light and the new participation fee is \$55. Please pay with your term fees.

## Bring
